GOAL 1:

INCREASE OUTREACH AND COMMUNITY PARTNERSHIPS TO BUILD & STRENGTHEN CONNECTIONS WITHIN THE COMMUNITY & REGION

- . ACTION: VISIT COMMUNITY EVENTS WITH THE BOOK BIKE
 - o Brrrr! We'll return to the streets of Amery in the Spring!
- ACTION: SEEK OUT SUSTAINABLE PARTNERSHIPS AND COLLABORATION OPPORTUNITIES WITH LOCAL BUSINESSES, THE AMERY SCHOOL DISTRICT, COMMUNITY ORGANIZATIONS, AND/OR OTHER MUNICIPAL DEPARTMENTS
 - Since September of 2023 the library has facilitated a 3rd Grade Book Club for Lien Lower Elementary Montessori Students
 - In December 2023 the library partnered with the Amery Police Department for the Giving Tree program. The generous citizens of Amery supplied a bounty of food for holiday meals for all 4 families at Northwoods Homeless Shelter
 - In January the Lien Elementary 4K & K students toured the library to learn about our programs, materials, and services.
 - The Amery Library is participating in the Amery Intermediate School Love Your Library event
 - The Amery Library Director is a Board Member of the Amery Area Historical Society, attends AAHS
 meetings, and serves as the Programming and Event Chair
 - The Amery Library Director is a member of the Amery Woman's Club and is co-chairing the Art & Craft Fair in 2024

 The Amery Library is a member of the Amery Community Club and participates in events throughout the year



GOAL 2: IMPROVE ACCESS TO LIBRARY MATERIALS AND SERVICES

ACTION: EVALUATE AND IMPROVE ACCESSIBILITY OF BUILDING AND SERVICES

- The Library has an accessibility audit scheduled for the end of February and will take action based on their recommendations
- o The Library is considering adding a book return to the Amery School District campus
- The Library has ordered a 24/7 Book Locker which should be installed by May
- ACTION: SEEK OUT INCREASED TRANSPORTATION OPPORTUNITIES TO THE AMERY AREA PUBLIC LIBRARY
 - The Youth Services Librarian is talking with the Amery School District on creation of potential bus drop at library
 - The Adult Services Librarian is talking with ADRC to explore potential for a "Lift to the Library" bus

ACTION: EXPLORE EXPANSION OF HOURS/ACCESS

- · Data is being gathered on foot traffic and circulation trends by hour
- · Quotes have been requested for book lockers

ACTION: INCREASE EXPENDITURES ON NONTRADITIONAL FORMATS

The 2024 budget has been adjusted to allow for more expenditures on nontraditional formats



GOAL 3:

ENHANCE LIBRARY PROGRAMMING TO BUILD CONNECTIONS WITHIN THE COMMUNITY

ACTION: ADD EVENING AND WEEKEND PROGRAMMING TO LIBRARY SCHEDULE

- The library now offers a Teen Thursday program once a month, from 6-8 PM
- The library offers one evening book club per month, Books & Brews
- The library offers one evening crafting class per month, Third Thursday
- The library offers one evening History program per month
- The library has begun a Saturday Storytime program, every Third Saturday, at 10 AM
- o The library has begun a Tween/Teen Brunch and Books, every Third Saturday from 12 PM to 1 PM
- The library is offers various Saturday programs

ACTION: IMPLEMENT INCREASED MULTIGENERATIONAL PROGRAMMING OPTIONS

- The Youth Services Librarian is working on scheduling at least one Summer Reading Program event at Golden Age Manor
- The library has opened the Galentine's Day event to ages 10 and up, allowing for intergenerational attendance

ACTION: PARTNER WITH HOMESCHOOLING FAMILIES

- The Youth Services Librarian is reaching out to known homeschooling families.
- ACTION: INCREASE TEEN/TWEEN PROGRAMMING
 - The library now offers a Teen Thursday program once a month, from 6-8 PM

o The library has begun a Tween/Teen Brunch and Books, every Third Saturday from 12 PM to 1 PM



GOAL 4: DEVELOP A LIBRARY AWARENESS PLAN TO IMPROVE WAYFINDING AND PROMOTE LIBRARY MATERIALS AND SERVICES

- ACTION: ADD SIGNAGE, MAPS, AND OTHER WAYFINDING AIDS TO ASSIST LIBRARY USERS IN NAVIGATING THE BUILDING
 - Accessibility audit took place in February 2024
 - Further action will be taken once results are in
- ACTION: HIGHLIGHT SPECIFIC LIBRARY SERVICES AND MATERIALS ON A REGULAR BASIS
 - Weekly newsletter and website now have a feature spotlight
 - New materials lists are updated on the website on a regular basis
- ACTION: CREATE ADDITIONAL READER'S ADVISORY TOOLS AND DISPLAYS
 - We are beginning to identify engaging reader's advisory tools
 - The library currently creates various displays throughout the building.
- ACTION: UPDATE AND MAINTAIN WEBSITE
 - · Circulation staff have been trained in the maintenance of digital lists of new materials on website
 - We will be collaborating with the Amery Area Historical society to add information on local history and in adding digital local history materials to library website
 - · We continue to create a weekly digital newsletter and add to website
