This week we kicked off our Summer Reading Program at the library! It runs until August 3rd and there are reading challenge programs for people of all ages. See below for more information.

Our first event was an interactive STEM show performed by Science Heroes! The Makerspace was full of grown-ups and children, who helped to conduct exciting science experiments.

Tuesday afternoon, we had an Ultimate Road Trip Planners event. Attendees planned their dream adventures, made Boredom Buster Kits for long car rides, and played Mario Kart!

Wednesday at 10:00 a.m. we had our regular Storytime program. After reading stories about balloons, children and caregivers worked together to craft paper hot air balloons with book characters as passengers. Some of these creations are in display in the picture book section... come check it out!

Thursday evening, we had a Pizza & Puzzle Competition. 39 people of all ages came. After eating a couple slices, teams competed to see who could make a 200-piece puzzle the fastest. The winning team completed their puzzle in 12 minutes and 32 seconds. All the members of the winning team got a free book, as did everyone under 18.

Next week at the library we are having our monthly meeting of the **Tortured Poets Club**, a meeting of the **Mystery Book Club**, two Strawberry Boba Tea events (one for ages **6-11** and one for ages **12+**), a **genealogy class**, and on Saturday the 15th our monthly **Saturday Storytime** and our tween & teen **Brunch and Books** book club.

The theme of our Summer Reading Program is Adventure Begins at Your Library. Join us for a summer of reading and activities for all ages!

We have two reading challenges as part of the program:

Youth (0-18) Challenge:

For every 75 minutes that you read, you get a raffle ticket for a chance to win a prize! Our prizes this summer include LEGOs, a full set of Harry Potter books, and more. You can also earn a raffle ticket for each program that you attend.

Adult (18+) Challenge:

This club is best suited for ages 6 and up.



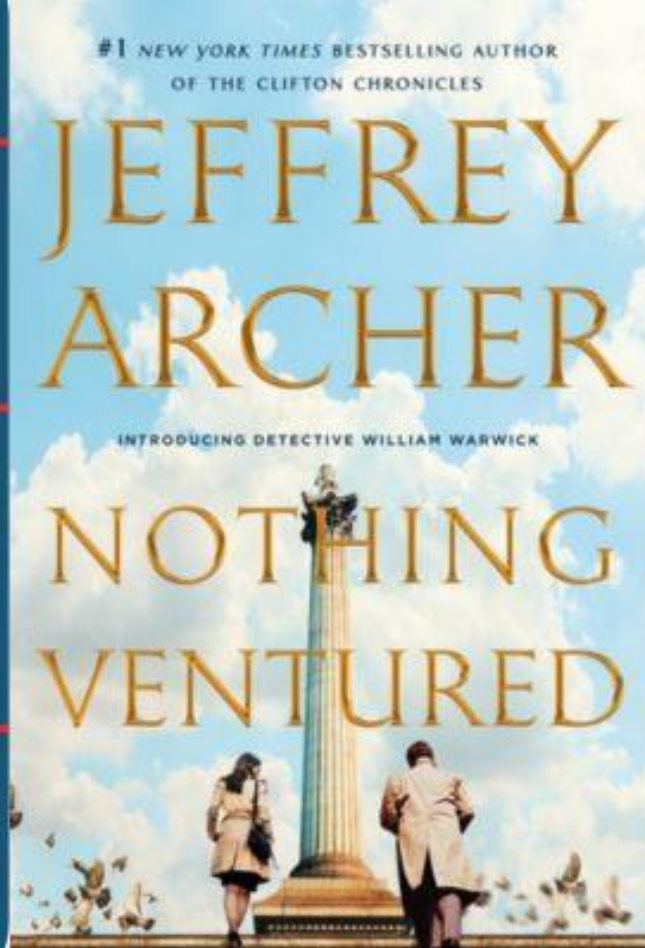
