It was a very busy week at the library! Saturday our staff rode Paperback Rider, our book bike, in the Amery Fall Festival Parade. Monday we were busy preparing for the arrival of new bookcases on Tuesday. Between Monday and Tuesday, we estimate we moved 20,000 books from the old shelves to book carts to the new shelves! ## Spotlight: Learn a Language



Need to learn a new language? Using your library card, you can learn more than 100 languages at home or on the go for free using the online Transparent Language program.

Languages range from Afrikaans to Zulu, and the number of languages available to learners is constantly growing. The system includes paired English materials for speakers of 30+ languages, intermediate- and advanced-level courses, an American Citizenship Test Prep course, and more. Placements tests let you see recommended courses and lessons for your level, or you can choose your own content. You can also focus on a specific skill by picking skills-based learning activities, selecting a desired vocabulary, and launching a custom lesson.

Note: At the current time, only human languages are included. Star Trek fans will need to look elsewhere to learn Klingon.


