Looking for digital books and magazines? Then you need the free Libby app! Using Libby you can borrow ebooks, audiobooks, magazines, and more from your local library for free! All you need is a library card and the Libby app.

All your loans, notes, bookmarks, and reading progress sync across your devices. Libby provides offline access to materials. Download e-books and e-audiobooks for offline reading or stream them to save storage space. You can enjoy audiobooks in your car through Apple CarPlay, Android Auto, or a Bluetooth connection. If you prefer reading on your Kindle, Libby can send your library books to it.

There is a Libby app for Apple iPhones and iPads, phones and tablets with Google Play, and Amazon Fire Tablets. On a computer you can use Libby by going to libbyapp.com

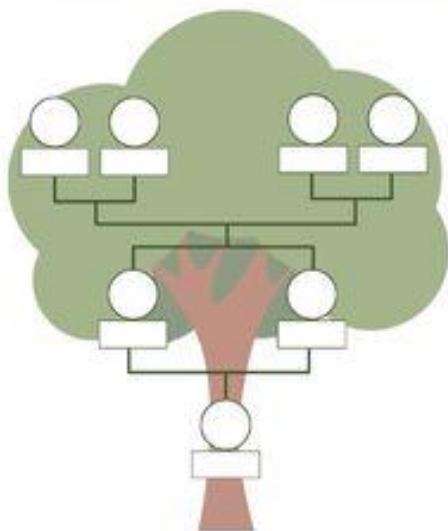

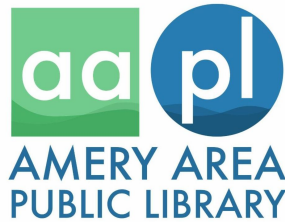
