Spotlight Article: Parenting Collection

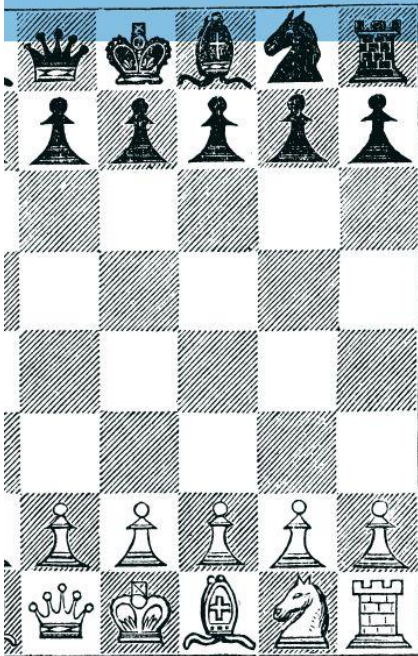
